READ: Deuteronomy 16



● v 12, 15:

The Lord admonishes you to be continually aware and grateful to Him about two issues:

- a. You were a bondman in Satan's Egypt of sin, judgement, curses and oppression, and He bought you back through the blood of His Son Jesus Christ shed to win you forgiveness and set you free. Give thanks to Him for your salvation and redemption.
- b. The Lord promises or assures you that He will bless you in all your efforts to seek increase (profit), and in all that you will set your hand to do. Live in expectation of this increase and blessing, and constantly thank God for it.

● Think on Jeremiah 29 v 11 - 13.

Take time to pray over these promises and to renew your mind into always looking forward to good things from a good Father God.

● v 12 - 15.

Take note that the Lord repeatedly says to you, "...and thou shalt rejoice..." True faith is living before God always with a continual rejoicing that comes from the appreciation of the good things He has done, is doing and shall do for you.

Take time to give thanks for all the good things from God in your life, past, present and future.

● Think on Philippians 4 v 4; Psalm 103.

Work to memorise this Psalm and to declare it out loud from time to time.
